- 44% of Y11 achieved Grade 4 or above in English and Maths. (Last year, national figure for all schools was 43%)
- 100% staying in education and transitioning to appropriate courses.
- For pupils with KS2 data, 66% made expected progress in English
- For pupils with KS2 data, 50% made expected progress in Maths
- 78% of pupils achieved at least a grade 4 in Science
- One grade 9 (Physics) Hardwick House's first!
- 100% of qualifications sat were passed with 61% at grade 4 or above
- Average attainment 8 score (Y11s) of 37 compared to a national average of 15.2 for pupils with an EHCP in all state-funded settings, and 3.3 in state-funded special settings. This compares to an average score of 39 last year.
- Learner CA did not attend school from December 2012 and was medically signed off. He sat his exams at home and gained 5
 GCSEs
- Four Y10 pupils achieved grade 5 GCSE Maths
